


LOOKBOOK



Jack and Stish were grandparents - Jack was a textile designer, and Stish an artist and practicer of home crafts. Jack met Stish in New York when he immigrated from Europe in the 1930s and they savored clothing and design as a way to express their creative freedom and to celebrate their lives and their connections with others. Their commitment to design and the love they shared inspired me to make this clothing line, which is a merging of art and life, style and comfort, past and future.

I have been designing patterns and having them digitally woven into blankets for several years, using source imagery from cultural memory, such as video games and abstracting them into patterns. While people love their blankets at home. I wanted to make something they could wear in daily life and transformed some of the blankets into clothing, two designs, each with 4 patterns. Like many parts of my practice, my jacket and design line has emerged organically - responding to the feedback of wearers as well as looking to the inspiration of past.

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jackets are unique and handmade, minimal in construction and one of a kind.






Inspired by 80s pop culture and nostalgic fashion, jack & stish is about uniqueness, positivity and warmth.

Each Jack & Stish piece is diverse, made to fit any body and any shape, expressing identity through abstract and psychedelic patterns.







